School Closure

When we started the new school year back in late August we really hoped we would get through the school year without any unforeseen closures. Of course, it was no major surprise when the daily Covid-19 infections started to rise significantly before Christmas that another prolonged school closure was on the cards. The children haven't set foot inside the school so far in 2021 and they are unlikely to do so for another few weeks at least. This is very disappointing but we really hope that we'll be back teaching them before St. Patrick's Day at the latest. Since January 11th we have been using the following timetable and we will be continuing with this same daily timetable, which has a mixture of "Zoom" (30/40 minute sessions daily) and Edmodo, for the next few weeks also. In addition to this timetable, Mrs Campbell (Learning Support) will continue with the Zoom sessions for the children who need some extra support in English and maths. Also, Nicola (SNA) will be continuing with her Zoom sessions on a daily basis.

I want to thank all the staff in Rathfeigh for the Trojan work they have done since the school opened in late August (teachers, SNA, secretary, caretaker and cleaner). They have worked tirelessly, and without complaint, in difficult circumstances for which I thank them. We also want to thank the children for their resilience and good humour in these difficult times. They have been FANTASTIC. The support of our Board of Management has also been invaluable.

Enrolments 2021/22

We have so much to offer children in Rathfeigh. We pride ourselves on achieving excellent results in the standardised tests in Irish, English and maths annually. We have the Literacy Lift Off reading programme up and running for eight years. This station-teaching approach to the teaching of literacy to children from Senior Infants to Second class has resulted in the vast majority of children being fluent independent readers by the time they get to Third class. We recently opened our computer room with the children regularly getting classes in IT which has significantly improved their computer skills. We achieved our first Green Flag last year for our great efforts in promoting a "Greener" culture throughout the school. Our mental health initiatives last year earned the "Amber Flag" for our school. Mental health issues among children are more prevalent than ever and we will have lessons regularly in all classes as part of the SPHE curriculum to promote and tackle mental health issues. We actively promote the participation in sports for boys and girls in all classes. We like to see the children being active at break-times playing a variety of games (e.g. soccer, skipping, hockey, gaelic football etc.). Our boys' and girls' gaelic football and rounders' teams have been very successful in recent years in the Cumann na mBunscol school competitions. We also encourage the children in all classes to participate in after-school activities in the school hall – Irish dancing, drama, gymnastics and basketball.

Rathfeigh NS has a vibrant and active Parents' Association. Their annual fundraising for the school has contributed significantly to the education and social development of the children. In recent years their fundraising has helped fund our new computer room and the purchase of classroom resources for the children as well as making contributions towards the cost of school tours and swimming excursions. New parents/guardians to the school are always encouraged to participate in the Association.
